Bighorn Meadows Resort is a nine-acre paradise in the giant playground known as The Columbia Valley.

A scenic walk from the village of Radium Hot Springs, Bighorn is surrounded on three sides by the Springs at Radium Golf Course. Fractional and whole ownership options are available for surprisingly affordable prices.

The resort offers one-, two- and three-bedroom suites, ranging from 780 to 1,424 square feet. Suites are outfitted with appliances, fireplaces and quality fixtures and furnishings such as tile, granite and leather furniture.

“It’s all the comforts of home, and then some,” says sales representative Randy Trapp.

Many of the Bighorn owners are middle-aged, married, empty-nesters. But the resort’s family-friendly environment draws a diverse crowd.

“We promote healthy living in one of the most inspiring and invigorating settings in the world,” says Trapp.

The views in Bighorn are breathtaking. Flanked by the Rocky and Purcell mountains on the west and east respectively, the development features 360 degrees of postcard scenery.

And buyers will be able to spend every minute of their time here enjoying the landscape and all it has to offer, because Bighorn offers maintenance-free living.

“There isn’t a single blade of grass with your name on it,” says Trapp. “You turn the key and the place is exactly the way you left it last time.”

Buyers can use the property for their own holidays or rent their suites out.

“And with a great rental management company in place, we remove the hassle of having a holiday home,” says developer Tim Tourond.

When fully developed, Bighorn Meadows will be a 180-unit complex featuring 106 condominium-style dwellings, about a

dozen townhomes and a 60-unit hotel and commercial property.

Phases 1 and 3 are already sold out, with limited fractional ownership available in Phases 2 and 4. Phase 6 is under construction, and fractional and quarter ownership is available.

Much of the interest in Bighorn Meadows comes from Calgary, because of the short 2.5-hour driving distance. But buyers from elsewhere in Alberta and British Columbia and beyond have snapped up prime units in the complex.

The resort itself has plenty to offer. As an owner of Bighorn Meadows, you will have access to preferred tee-times at the Springs Golf Course, the Resort Golf Course, Greywolf Golf Course, Copper Point Golf Course and Eagle Ranch Golf Course.

You’ll also have access to a welcome centre that features a swimming pool, hot tub, kiddie pool and playground. There are also showers and change rooms at the centre, along with a barbecue area, meeting lounge and a reservation desk.

But that’s just the beginning of what awaits Bighorn Meadows buyers.

In addition to the luxurious hot springs for which it’s named, the Radium area offers extensive hiking and biking trails, hang gliding and paragliding, river rafting and world-class downhill and cross-country skiing.

“If you can do it in the Rockies, you can do it within an hour’s drive of Radium,” says Trapp. “Come pay us a visit. You won’t regret it.”
